IN THE MEANTIME- COMFORT COMES

The Praise Team will be sharing a message in song this Sunday titled "Comfort Comes" Here is the preface to this song by the songwriter Mike Harland.

"The news was so sudden. A coworker at LifeWay had just learned that a recent test confirmed a diagnosis of advanced cancer. The next few months would be intense with surgery and treatments, doctors' offices, and kneeling benches at church.

I reached out to him with a short email, assuring him of my prayers as he faced the road ahead. His reply inspired this song: Thanks so much for your prayers— comfort comes. I was so taken by this simple phrase of faith that I immediately started writing down a lyric.

Once it was complete, I shared it with Phillip Keveren, just to see if the lyric would inspire a musical setting. Within a few days, he had completed the whole song. Now, several years later, the friend who inspired this song is a living testimony that a sovereign God can take us through the hardest battles.

Recently, I've also experienced the loss of a friend that God chose to bring home instead of giving him healing and more time on earth. In both instances, comfort came from our Heavenly Father. I'm excited about this song because it's true. Comfort does come when we place our lives and circumstances into the care of our Savior-whether He heals on earth or when He gives the ultimate healing to the believer through death. Either way and always, when we rest in His hands, comfort comes."
