IN THE MEANTIME- ALL THE PRAISE

In Philippians 2, we see a beautiful description of Christ's example of humility and a call for believers to be of one mind, unified in Christ. Verses 3 and 4 encourage us: "Do nothing from rivalry or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others." Even Jesus—God in the flesh—came not to be served, but to serve. He was obedient to the Father's will, even to the point of death on a cross. Because of His humility, God exalted Him and "bestowed on Him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" (verses 9–11).

This Sunday, the choir will share a song titled "All the Praise." The phrase "all the praise goes to Jesus" powerfully expresses that all glory, honor, and adoration belong to Him alone—because of His humility in serving mankind, taking our place, and paying the price for our sin. The lyrics are a moving reminder of who Jesus is and the overwhelming gratitude and awe we owe Him. He is the One who spoke countless stars into existence, breathed life into clay, calmed raging seas, left heaven for the cross, knows every pain and loss, died to save our souls, crushed the curse of sin, rose to life again, and is coming back for you and for me!
